Photography Competition I “Cohasset 250th Celebration” **Thursday, June 25** Cohasset Historical Society

Photographs should include as their main focus the interpretation of “Cohasset 250th Celebration” as described in the four classes below. Each class will include four to eight entries (will subdivide classes with 6 or more entries). Exhibitors may enter two classes but only one entry per class. Classes will be filled on a first come basis.

Class 1 - Village

Photographs of any and all things in Cohasset Village (the Common & Downtown).

Class 2 - Beach

Photographs that capture beach life in Cohasset (images from Sandy beach, Rocky beach, private beaches, etc).

Class 3 - Harbor

Photographs capturing Cohasset Harbor (i.e. water, buildings, boats, sunsets/sunrise, fishing, etc.)

Class 4 - Agriculture

Photographs capturing Agriculture in Cohasset (i.e. plants, livestock, land, buildings, equipment, Holly Hill Farm, private property, farmers market, etc.)

Class 5 - Guest Class

Garden club guests or significant others can participate in CGC’s Cohasset 250th Photography show too! Guests are welcome to submit photographs in any of the above categories for an honorary non-judged showing.

Registration forms should be sent to Sue Hess at rwsjhess@comcast.net by June 15th. Notification of acceptance will be sent out after receipt of entries.

The deadline is June 19th for all photographs to be dropped off at Sue’s house (58 Old Coach Road, Cohasset). The size of the photographs should be a minimum perimeter of 36 inches (which could be 8x10”) or a maximum of 40 inches in diameter. Photographs can be glossy or matte and must be mounted on **black** foam board.

Photographs should include as their main focus the interpretation of “Colors” described in the classes below. Photographs can be urban or rural scenes, portraits, close-ups, street photography, travel adventures, landscapes, still-life, portrait, nature, wildlife, architecture, fashion and more. The images to capture are endless! Each class will include four to eight entries. Exhibitors may enter two classes but only one entry per class.

Classes will be filled on a first come basis.

Class 1 - Red

Photographs of any images with the color Red as the main focal point.

Class 2 - Blue

Photographs of any images with the color Blue as the main focal point.

Class 3 - Yellows

Photographs of any images with the color Yellow as the main focal point.

Class 4 - Black & White

Photographs of any images in Black & White.

The deadline is September 18th for all photographs to be dropped off at Sue’s house (58 Old Coach Road, Cohasset).
